## अमृतकाल में विकसित भारत में अपना योगदान सुनिश्चित करें

प्रधानमंत्री श्री नरेन्द्र मोदी जी ने आजादी के अमृत महोत्सव के अवसर पर लालकिले की प्राचीर से देश को संबोधित करते हुए आगामी 25 वर्षों का लक्ष्य विकसित भारत के रूप में देशवासियों के सामने रखा। भारत को विकसित राष्ट्र बनाने में सरकार से ज्यादा महत्वपूर्ण भूमिका देश के नागरिकों की रहने वाली है। भाई भतीजावाद, परिवारवाद एवं भ्रष्टाचार से इस देश को मुक्त कराने में प्रधानमंत्री जी ने देश के नागरिकों का सहयोग माँगा है। हम सब भलीभाँति जानते हैं कि इन बुराइयों के कारण ही पिछले 75 वर्षों के दौरान हमारा देश विकसित देशों की कतार में खड़ा नहीं हो सका। इसलिए आगामी 25 वर्षों के दौरान इन बुराइयों से लड़ने का संकल्प हम सबको लेना ही पड़ेगा। यदि जनता परिवारवाद, भाई भतीजावाद एवं भ्रष्टाचार को बढ़ावा देने वाले नेताओं और पार्टियों को समर्थन नहीं देने का मन बना लेगी तो राजनैतिक दलों और नेताओं को अपनी रीति-नीति बदलने के लिए विवश होना पड़ेगा। इसलिए विकसित भारत के निर्माण में भारत के प्रत्येक नागरिक का योगदान यही हो सकता है कि हम भाई भतीजावाद, परिवारवाद एवं भ्रष्टाचार करने वालों को पूरी तरह नकारने का निर्णय करें।

हमारा सौभाग्य है कि देश का नेतृत्व आज चुनाव में हार-जीत की चिंता करने की बजाय आगामी 25 वर्षों में भारत को विकसित राज्य बनाने का लक्ष्य निर्धारित करके काम कर रहा है। पिछले 7-8 वर्षों के दौरान देश ने कुछ असंभव से लगने वाले काम करके दिखाए हैं। अयोध्या में राम मन्दिर का निर्माण होना, कश्मीर से धारा 370 समाप्त होना, तीन तलाक को कानूनी रूप से अपराध के दायरे में रखना, पूरे देश के लिए एक समान कर प्रणाली जीएसटी को लागू करना, काले धन की व्यवस्था समाप्त करने के लिए नोट बंदी लागू करना, खुले में शौच से मुक्ति प्रदान करना, करोड़ों लोगों का पक्का मकान सुनिश्चित करना, 80 करोड़ लोगों को लगभग 3 वर्ष से निशुल्क भोजन उपलब्ध करवाना, पूरी दुनिया को कोरोना वैक्सीन उपलब्ध करवाना एवं देश में 200 करोड़ लोगों को निःशुल्क कोरोना का टीका लगाना, सैन्य सामग्री एवं हथियार विदेश से आयात करने की बजाए भारत में ही निर्मित करने का काम करना जैसे असंभव से लगने वाले कामों को भारत ने पूरा करके दिखाया है। इससे स्पष्ट है कि 2047 तक भारत को विकसित देशों की कतार में शामिल करना एवं दुनिया की तीसरी सबसे बड़ी अर्थव्यवस्था बनाने का लक्ष्य भी भारत एक सक्षम नेतृत्व एवं नागरिकों के सहयोग के बल पर प्राप्त कर सकता है।

महाराजा अग्रसेन टेक्निकल एजुकेशन सोसायटी पिछले 24 वर्षों से राष्ट्र निर्माण के काम में संलग्न है। 1999 में पहले बैच महाराजा अग्रसेन इन्स्टीट्यूट ऑफ टेक्नोलॉजी में प्रवेश लिया था एवं इस समय 23वें बैच में प्रवेश प्रक्रिया चल रही है। इस वर्ष मेट में भी बी.बी.ए. की शिक्षा प्रारंभ हो रही है एवं 60 सीटों पर प्रवेश दिया जा रहा है। इस प्रकार मेम्स में इस वर्ष एल.एल.एम. की शिक्षा प्रारंभ हो रही है एवं 30 सीटों पर प्रवेश की प्रक्रिया चल रही है। मेट एवं मेम्स दोनों को अब स्नातकोत्तर स्तर के शिक्षण संस्थान का दर्जा प्राप्त हो गया है। सोसायटी द्वारा संचालित मेट, मेम्स एवं महाराजा अग्रसेन विश्वविद्यालय में इस वर्ष विद्यार्थियों की संख्या 10000 के आकड़े को पार कर जाएगी। हमारे संस्थानों की लोकप्रियता दिन-प्रतिदिन बढ़ती जा रही है। हमारे कई विद्यार्थियों ने इन्द्रप्रस्थ विश्वविद्यालय में प्रथम स्थान प्राप्त करते हुए गोल्ड मेडल हासिल करने में सफलता प्राप्त की है जिनका विस्तृत विवरण इस अंक में प्रकाशित किया जा रहा है। इसी प्रकार हमारे संस्थानों से निकलने वाले विद्यार्थियों को बहुराष्ट्रीय कम्पनियों द्वारा दिया जाने वाला पैकेज भी लगातार बढ़ रहा है। इस वर्ष हमारे एक विद्यार्थी को एक करोड़ रुपये का पैकेज मिला है। 50 लाख रुपये से अधिक का पैकेज प्राप्त करने वाले अनेक विद्यार्थी हैं। प्लेसमेंट से संबंधित विस्तृत जानकारी भी इस अंक में प्रदान की जा रही है।

सोसायटी द्वारा बढ़ी हिमाचल प्रदेश में संचालित महाराजा अग्रसेन विश्वविद्यालय में आगामी शिक्षण सत्र से मेडिकल की पढ़ाई प्रारम्भ करने के लिए आवश्यक निर्माण कार्य तेजी से चल रहा है। शिक्षण सत्र 2023-24 में वहाँ नर्सिंग कॉलेज एवं पैरा मेडिकल की शिक्षा प्रारम्भ हो जाएगी। इसके लिए विधिवत् कंसल्टेंट्स की नियुक्ति कर ली गई है जिसके द्वारा तमाम औपचारिकताओं को पूरा करने का काम किया जा रहा है। इसके लिए विश्वविद्यालय परिसर में 200 बिस्तारों का हॉस्पिटल निर्मित किया जा रहा है। इस नए विश्वविद्यालय में निर्माण कार्यों पर 200 करोड़ रुपये खर्च किए जाएँगे। यह धन राशि ट्रस्टी भाइयों के सहयोग से जुटाने का प्रयास किया जाएगा एवं आवश्यकता पड़ने पर सीएसआर के माध्यम से एवं बैंकों से ऋण लेकर भी निर्माण कार्य पूरा किया जाएगा। एचडीएफसी बैंक से सस्ती दरों पर ऋण प्रदान करने की स्वीकृति मिल चुकी है। महाराजा अग्रसेन विश्वविद्यालय परिसर के साथ ही 50 एकड़ जमीन और खरीद ली गई है जिससे भविष्य में विश्वविद्यालय के विस्तार में जगह की कमी का सामना नहीं करना पड़ेगा। मेट एवं मेम्स परिसर में भी एक लाख वर्ग फुट का निर्माण कार्य चल रहा है, जिसमें 50 हजार वर्ग फुट का ढाँचा बन कर तैयार हो चुका है। मेट एवं मेम्स परिसर में इस वर्ष निर्माण कार्यों पर 25 करोड़ रुपये खर्च किए जाएँगे।

2023-24 शिक्षण सत्र से सोसायटी का रजत जयंती वर्ष प्रारम्भ होगा। इस वर्ष को यादगार एवं प्रेरक बनाने के लिए सोसायटी द्वारा एक कमेटी का गठन किया गया है जो पूरे वर्ष चलने वाले कार्यक्रमों की रूपरेखा तैयार करेगी। रजत जयंती वर्ष पूरा होने तक सोसायटी द्वारा वर्तमान में चल रहे सभी निर्माण कार्यों को पूरा कर लेने के संकल्प के साथ काम किया जा रहा है। रजत जयंती वर्ष में एक स्मारिका प्रकाशित करने का भी निर्णय किया गया है जिसके लिए समिति बनाई गई है। सोसायटी के प्रधान विनीत कुमार लोहिया जी के नेतृत्व में सभी पदाधिकारियों द्वारा तन-मन-धन से सहयोग किया जा रहा है। इस टीम के प्रयासों का ही परिणाम है कि कोरोना संक्रमण के दौरान भी सोसायटी द्वारा एक भी व्यक्ति को सेवा से मुक्त करने की आवश्यकता नहीं पड़ी एवं सभी लोगों को नियमित रूप से वेतन प्रदान किया गया। कोरोना संक्रमण के कारण विद्यार्थियों एवं स्टाफ में यदि किसी के भी परिवार में कोई दुःख घटना घटी तो सोसायटी ने उसकी पूरी मदद की। आज भी 50 विद्यार्थी ऐसे हैं जो विभिन्न परेशानियों के कारण फीस देने में असमर्थ हैं लेकिन उनकी पढ़ाई में किसी प्रकार का व्यवधान नहीं आने दिया गया। सोसायटी का संकल्प है कि किसी भी विद्यार्थी की शिक्षा धन के अभाव में अधूरी नहीं रहनी चाहिए। हमारा लक्ष्य विश्व नागरिक तैयार करना है जो न केवल कुशल इंजीनियर एवं प्रबंधक हो बल्कि पूरी दुनिया में भारतीय संस्कृति का आदर्श भी प्रस्तुत कर सकें। आज हमारे 1000 से अधिक विद्यार्थी विभिन्न देशों में काम करते हुए अपनी योग्यता एवं मानवता के बल पर हमारी संस्था एवं देश का नाम रोशन कर रहे हैं।

1. "During second year of college, I started learning to code in C++. I used GeeksForGeeks for understanding DSA topics and Hacker-rank to practice questions. I gave weekly contests on code-forces to practice doing questions in a time constraint. CP helps provoke our thoughts and manage time during an interview or online test. I started doing DSA questions on a daily basis as consistency is most important to achieve one's goals. In final year I solved the SDE sheet by Striver. That sheet helped me a lot in revision.
2. During placement season, I started applying to jobs off campus, like six-month intern and FTE. LinkedIn and Telegram groups major sources for finding out the opportunities. I faced many rejections in interviews and online tests but got an internship at Zigram, a company

based in Gurugram.

3. I applied at Amazon Dublin in October first week through their career portal and got the online test link. The test consisted of two coding questions, MCQs and some debugging questions. Finally "workstyle assessment." test was conducted. Three virtual interviews were scheduled for a week later. All the interviews were on the same day and lasted an hour each. The first two interviews were on the same pattern where I was asked some questions based on leadership principles which Amazon follows. After that, a coding question was asked. The third round was based on object-oriented design. The very next day, I got a call from the recruiter congratulating me for clearing the interviews and getting an offer from the company.
4. I remember reading somewhere "rejection is just a redirection". This line stuck with me. I am lucky to have really great friends who lifted my spirit whenever I felt down. As I look back I have nothing but gratitude towards my family, friends, institute and teachers." ○

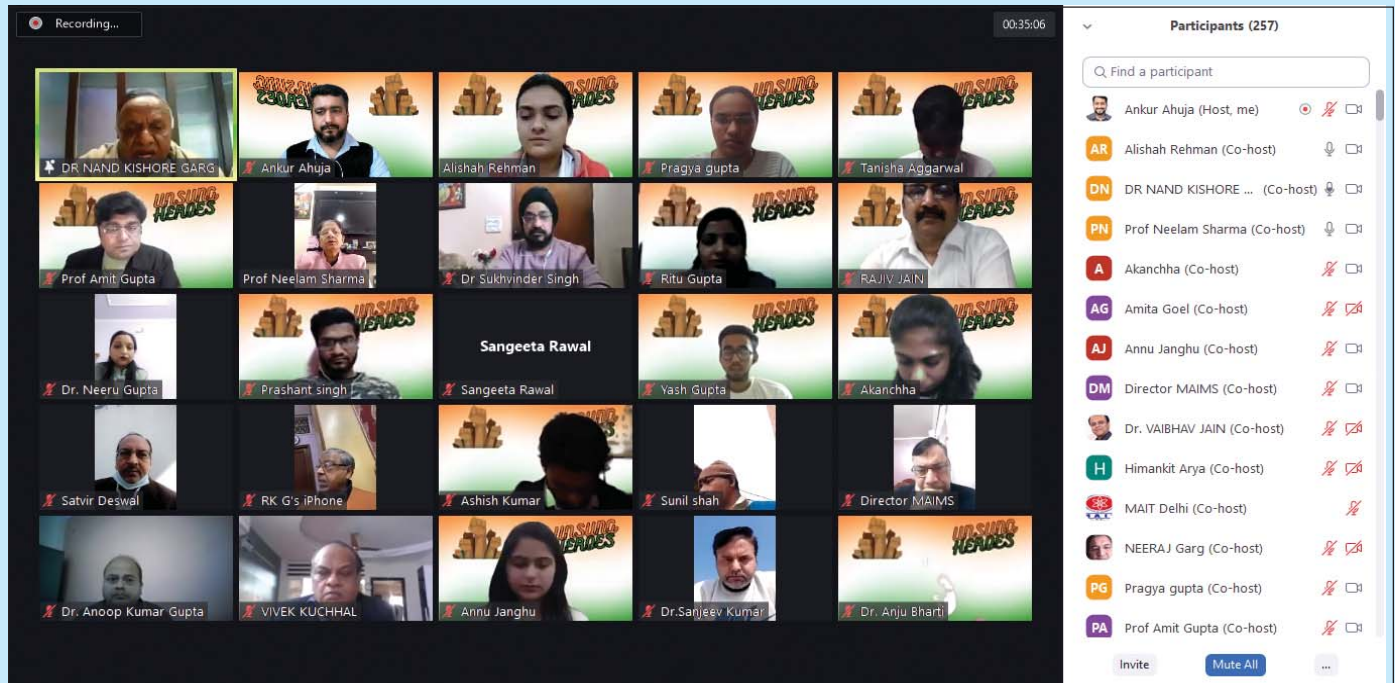

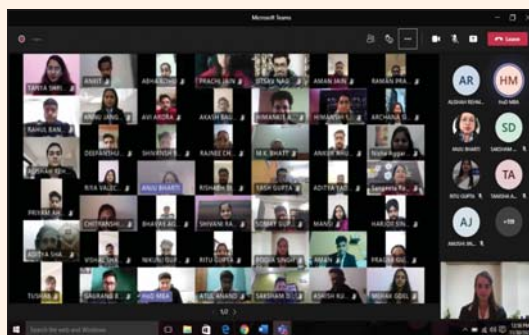

Second Prize: Rs. 7,000/- won by team CoviCure from



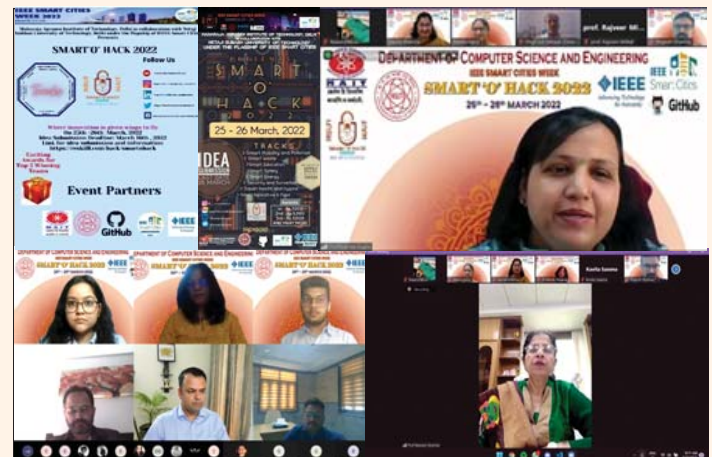

Department of Mechanical & Automation Engineering along with ASHRAE Student Branch Technology organized an online webinar on "Problem Solving & Creativity" on 23rd October 2021. The event was graced by Prof. Victor Goldschmidt, Emeritus Purdue Professor of Mechanical Engineering, Fellow and Past Director at-Large of ASHRAE and honorary member of the IIR (International Institute of Refrigeration), ACAIRE (Colombia Association of Air Conditioning and Refrigeration), AAF (Argentine Association of Cold) and ASURVAC (Uruguay Association of Refrigeration, Ventilation, Air Conditioning and Heating). His talk comprised of the adoption of introspection model which is needed to enrich the engineering skills. There is a dramatic difference between the problem solving techniques presented to us in formal engineering courses and the skills that are called for in actual practice. These differences were outlined, leading to a special focus on the need for cooperation between creativity and problem solving in engineering applications. The lecture presented the general steps in problem solving of definition, recasting, ideation, convergence, and validation/implementation. The lecture ended with a listing of 'pet-peeves' which included confusing cause and effect and violating the scientific method. The speaker stressed on the call for creativity among engineering students. The nature of creativity, and methods to enhance creativity were outlined challenging each individual to personalize the comments.

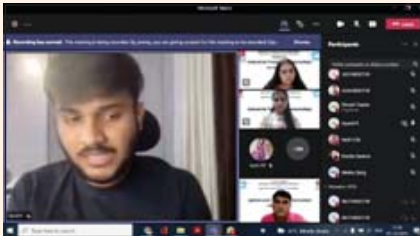

## EVENTS ORGANISED BY TECHCOM

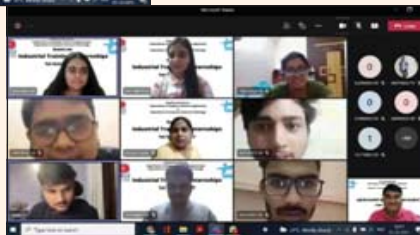
### 1. 'Industrial Training and Internships'

### 2. Workshop on "Problem Solving Techniques" at DRDO

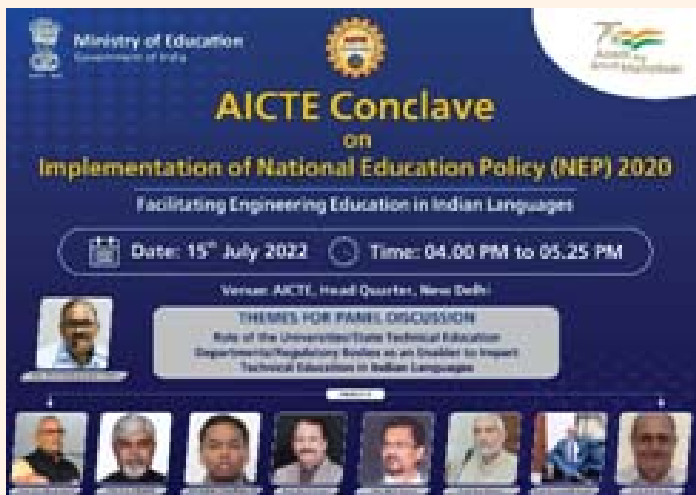

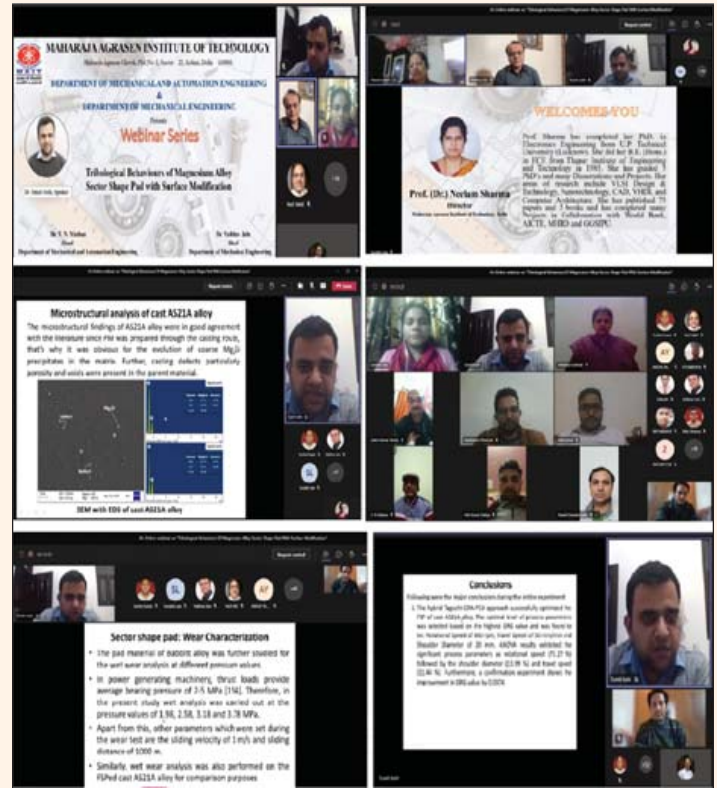
After the lab processing the students went for the balancing units and storage warehouse.

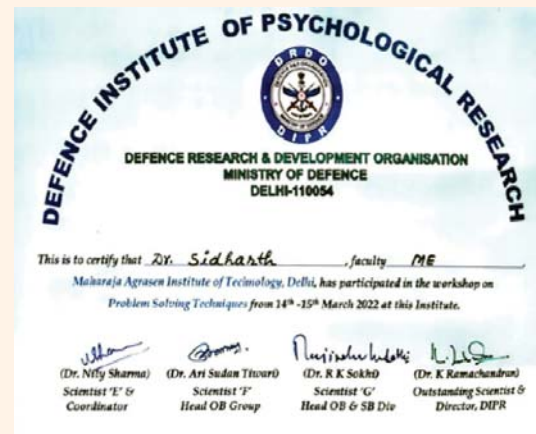
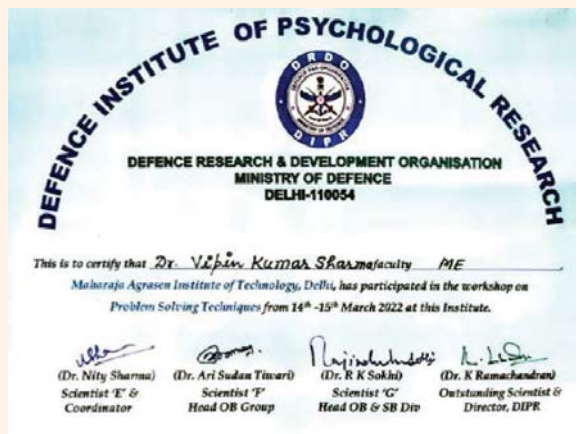

Department of Mechanical & Automation Engineering and Department of Mechanical Engineering organized a webinar on the topic "Tribological behaviors of magnesium alloy sector shape pad with surface modification" on 8th January 2022. Dr. Sumit Joshi presented magnesium alloy sector shape pad with adoption of Friction Stir Processing (FSP). Further, the principle of FSP was very well explained along with the supporting literature. Dr. Sumit Joshi presented a talk discussing about the Friction Stir Processing (FSP), a surface modification technique, used for investigation of the properties of Magnesium alloys. The talk started with the introduction of various types of magnesium alloys and their applications. Further, the principle of FSP was explained with supporting literature. Dr. Sumit listed the various types of equipment utilized for achieving the research objectives. The speaker briefly explained the influence of microstructural features obtained after FSP on the mechanical and tribological properties of magnesium alloys. ## INDUSTRIAL VISIT TO MULTICOLOR PVT. LMT.



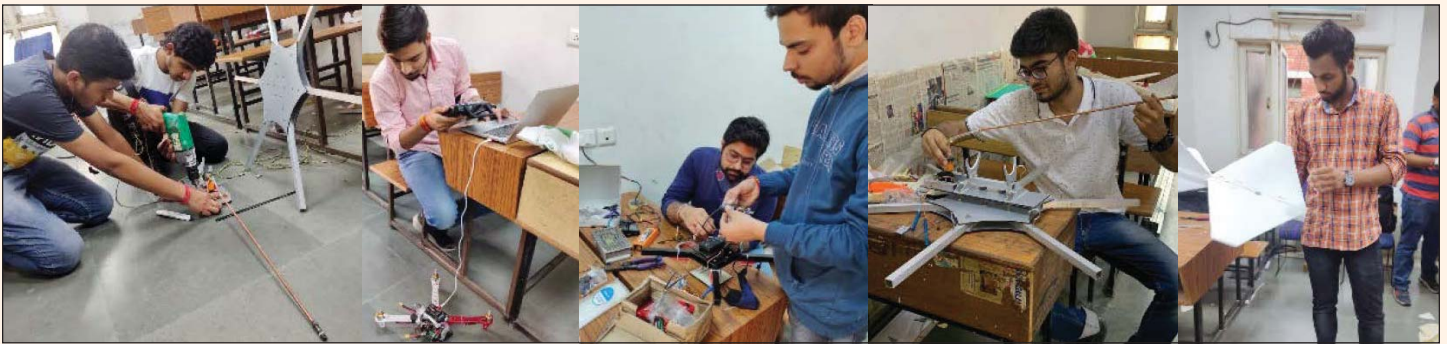

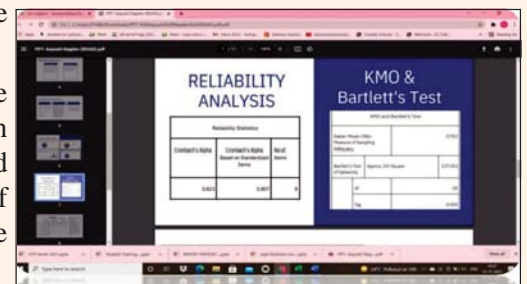

## ANVESHAN 3.0: THE SUMMER TRAINING PROJECT COMPETITION



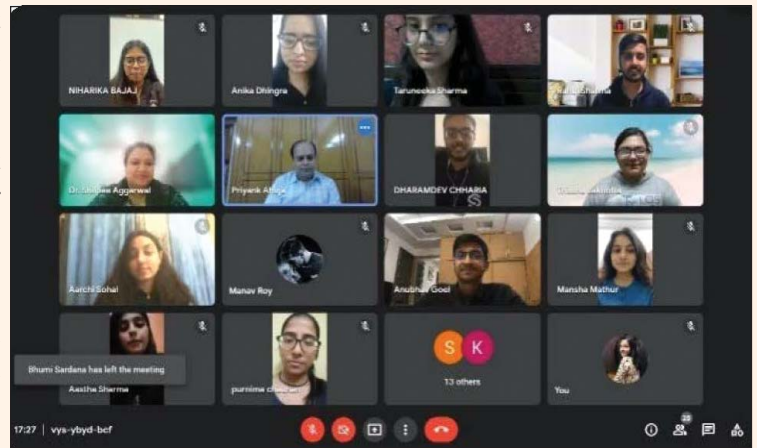

## WEBINAR: ACID ATTACK - UNCIVILIZED AND HEARTLESS CRIME

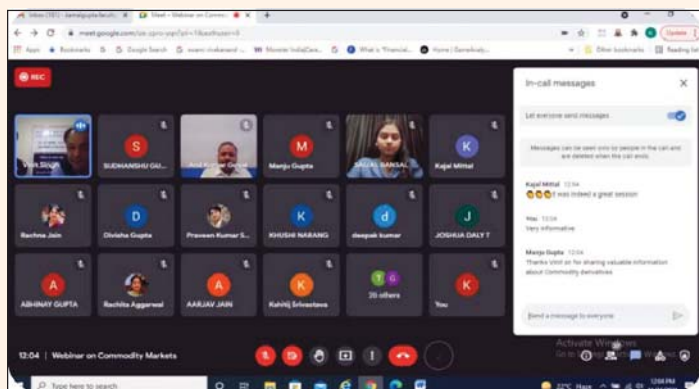

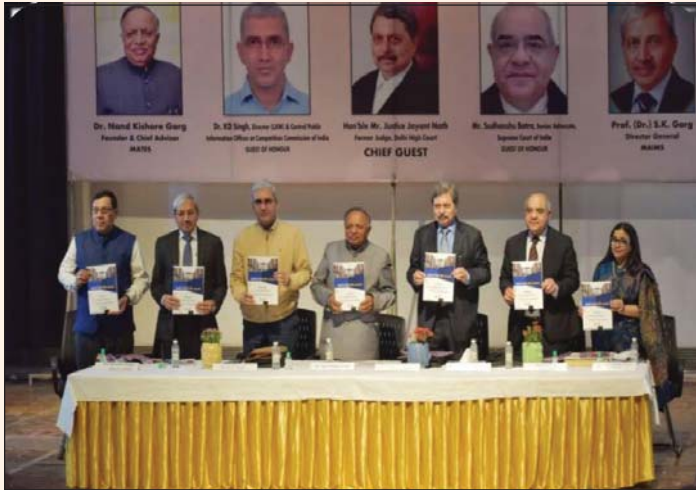
## WEBINAR: PITCHING AND BUSINESS MODEL CANVAS (BMC)

## 2ND NATIONAL MOOT COURT COMPETITION & CONSTITUTION DAY CELEBRATION



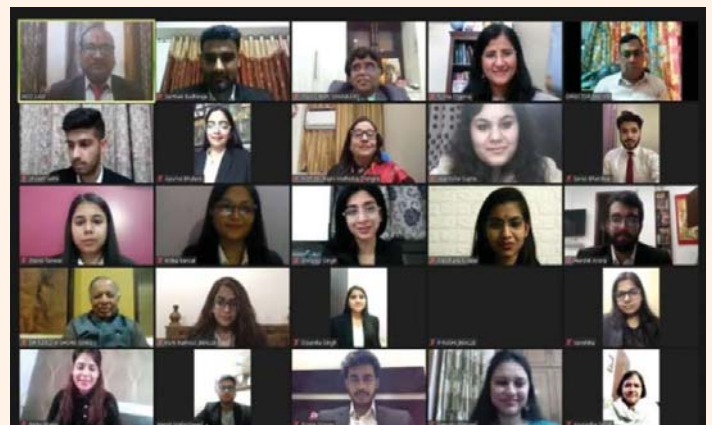

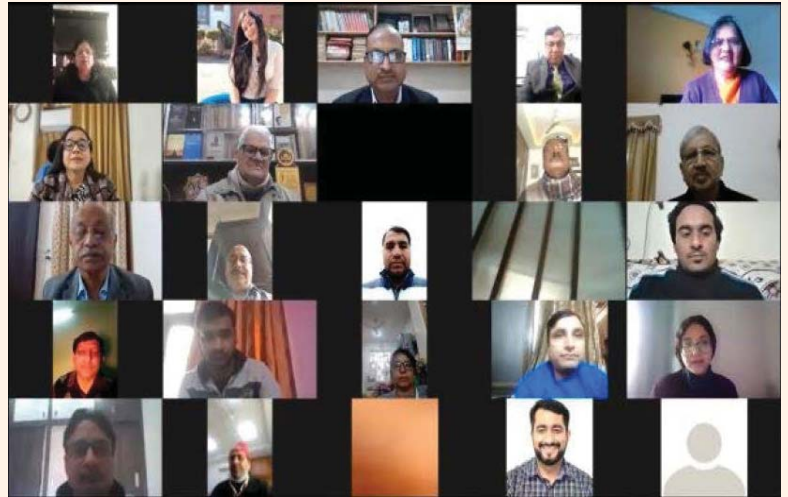

## POSTER MAKING COMPETITION: INCREDIBLE NETAJI

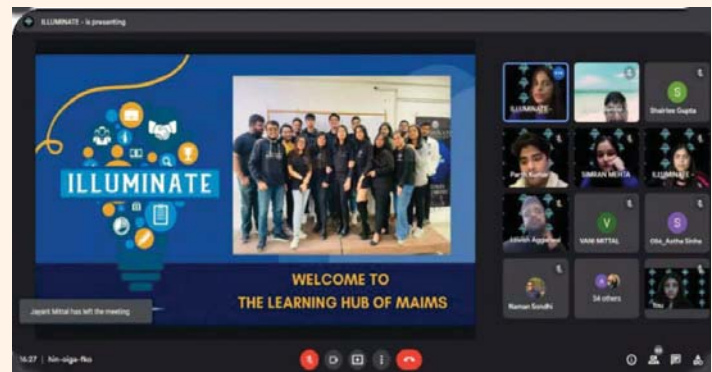

Govt is providing incentives to star-ups under Start-up India program. She also elaborated about the young youth inventors who introduced new inventions like- KalamSat, Beacon etc. This programme was indeed very insightful to understand the basic nuances of IPR and its relevance with today's youth career.

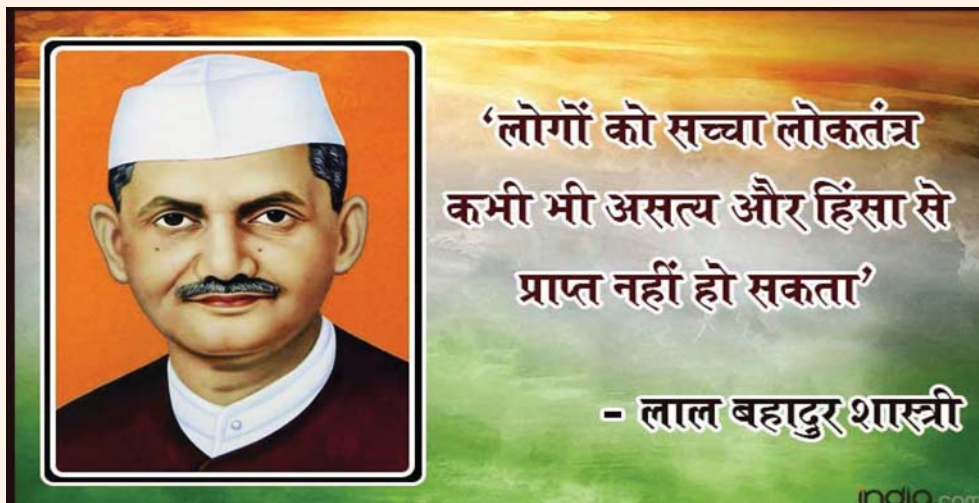

## METaverse- THE NEXT WAVE OF DIGITAL DISRUPTION

While Hollywood movie "Ready Player One" presents a virtual world as infinitely superior to the real world, The Metaverse, at its best, will complement rather than compete with the real world, enhancing our real-life experiences rather than replacing them.

The word 'meta' means 'beyond' and 'verse' means 'universe'. It is a network of 3D virtual world that combines the physical world with the digital world. It makes use of features of social media, Online gaming, Virtual reality (VR), Augmented Reality (AR) and Cryptocurrency to enable users to meet, chat, work, play and interacts with other users. One can reside in the form of avatar in the virtual world and can perform all day-to-day activities as they do in real life. Technologies like AI, ML and IoT are going to play a pivotal role in the development of metaverse.

The metaverse has the potential to impact everything from employee engagement to the customer experience, omnichannel sales and marketing, product innovation, and community building.

One of the most prominent features of metaverse will be smart contracts, that allows users to transact anonymously without knowing each other with no need of any mediator party. Thus, giving a new future to easily manage wallets, infrastructure, transactional processing in the form of NFTs (non-fungible tokens) and many more. Various corporation like Tanishq, Tata, MG are shifting towards this new paradigm.

Companies like Facebook, Microsoft, Google, Nvidia, Apple, Decentraland are targeting implementing a metaverse for various use cases.

Microsoft Mesh for Teams (built on mixed reality) - which anyone will be able to access from standard smartphones and laptops to mixed-reality headsets - is designed to make online meetings more personal, engaging and fun. Mark Zuckerberg (CEO of Facebook) has planned to use a metaverse to support remote work and improve economic prospects in developing countries. Even, in October 2021 Facebook has changed its brand name to Metato focus on the metaverse

While there is significant growth in this area, there are still many questions remain, including but not limited to:

- How to create a balance between Virtual and Physical world to ensure the metaverse is built in a responsible manner
- How will it provide a safe environment for consumers
- Technology limitation in building the metaverse.

As per McKinsey, with its potential to generate up to \$5 trillion in value by 2030, the metaverse is too big for companies to ignore.

## भारतीय स्वतंत्रता संग्राम में कलम का अग्निपथ

वर्तमान में पत्रकारिता की विश्वसनीयता पर नित नए प्रश्न चिह्न खड़े हो रहे हैं। बार-बार यह महसूस होता है कि राष्ट्रवाद या राष्ट्रीयता जैसे शब्द बाजारवाद और निहित स्वार्थों की भेंट चढ़ गए हैं। पत्रकारिता जो कभी मिशन हुआ करती थी, अब कमीशन का सा आभास भी देती है। कई बार ऐसे उदहारण भी सामने आये हैं जब मीडिया देशहित के खिलाफ खड़ा दिखाई दिया। ऐसे में जरूरत महसूस होती है वर्तमान के झरोखे से पत्रकारिता के उस गौरवमयी इतिहास में झांकने की, जो राष्ट्रवाद की भावना से ओतप्रोत है।

भारत में पत्रकारिता की शुरुआत ही गलत के खिलाफ मुहिम से हुई और फिर इसने एक ऐसी शौर्य-गाथा रच डाली जिसकी दूसरी मिसाल पूरी दुनिया में नहीं मिलती। इन अखबारों में प्रकाशित सामग्री और उनमें छुपे क्रांति और स्वतंत्र भारत के संदेशों ने ब्रिटिश राज की चूलें हिला दीं थीं। अन्याय, अत्याचार, अनाचार, अज्ञानता, उत्पीड़न, शोषण, दमन, अन्धविश्वास, पाखण्ड, रूढ़िवादिता के खिलाफ हमारे पत्रकारों, संपादकों ने अलग-अलग भाषाओं में अखबार और पत्रिकाओं के माध्यम से जिस प्रकार पूरे देश में बिगुल फूँका उससे सोया हुआ समाज और देश ब्रिटिश सत्ता के पंजों से आजादी की लड़ाई लड़ सका।

1780 में भारत के पहले अखबार 'बंगाल गजट' या 'कैलकटा जनरल एडवर्टाइजर' के सम्पादक जेम्स औगस्टस हिक्की ने जब ईस्ट इंडिया कंपनी के भ्रष्ट अधिकारियों के खिलाफ अपने अखबार में छापना शुरू किया तो उन्हें न केवल जेल की सलाखें, जुर्माना भुगतना पड़ा, बल्कि देश निकाला तक मिला। यह तो शुरुआत भर थी, फिर तो यह सिलसिला बदस्तूर जारी रहा और पत्रकारों, संपादकों को नित नयी यातनाओं का सामना करना पड़ा।

इन अखबारों के पन्नों में दर्ज है भारत की अंग्रेजों की गुलामी से मुक्ति की पूरी दास्ताँ। ये अखबार न केवल रोजमर्रा की घटनाओं को अपने पन्नों में दर्ज करते रहे, बल्कि ब्रिटिश सत्ता के खिलाफ क्रांति की ज्वाला धधकाने में घी का काम करते रहे। वे संपादक और प्रकाशक किसी बन्दूक, तोप या तलवार से नहीं लड़े, उनका हथियार था कलम। उनकी कलम में वो ताकत थी, जिसने क्रांति की चिंगारी को आग की लपटों में बदल दिया।

उदहारण के लिए ऐसे ही एक अखबार 'पयाम-ए आजादी', जिसे 1857 की क्रांति का मुखपत्र भी कहा जाता था, के मास्टहेड पर प्रकाशित अंग्रेजी हुकूमत को ललकारती इन पंक्तियों को देखा जा सकता है। इसमें जनमानस को झिंझोड़ देने वाला यह झंडा गीत भी छपता था-



आज शहीदों ने तुमको अहले-वतन ललकारा,  
तोड़ो गुलामी की जंजीरें, बरसाओ अंगारा,  
हिन्दू, मुस्लिम, सिक्ख हमारा भाई भाई प्यारा,  
यह है आजादी का झंडा, इसे सलाम हमारा॥

एक नजर डालते हैं स्वतंत्रता आन्दोलन में प्रमुख भूमिका निभाने वाले कुछ समाचारपत्रों और उनमें प्रकाशित सामग्री के चुने हुए अंशों पर-

### देहली उर्दू अखबार-

भारत में अंग्रेजों के खिलाफ और स्वराष्ट्र हित में पत्रकारिता के कारण पहली शहादत 'देहली उर्दू अखबार' के संपादक-प्रकाशक मौलवी मोहम्मद वाकर की हुई जो 1837 से यह अखबार निकल रहे थे। 17 सितम्बर, 1857 को उन्हें दिल्ली दरवाजे के सामने नीम के पेड़ से लटकाकर तोप से उड़ा दिया गया।

### पयाम-ए-आजादी-

दिल्ली से प्रकाशित इस उर्दू अखबार को 1857 की क्रांति का मुखपत्र भी कहा जाता है। इसके संपादक थे क्रांतिकारी अजीमुल्ला खां और प्रकाशक थे अंतिम मुगल बादशाह बहादुर शाह जफर के पोते बेदार बख्त। इसके मास्टहेड पर अंग्रेजों को ललकारने वाली ये पंक्तियाँ लिखी होती थीं-

हम हैं इसके मालिक हिन्दोस्ताँ हमारा।  
पाक वतन है कौम का जन्मत से भी प्यारा॥

इतना ही नहीं, इसमें जनमानस को झिंझोड़ देने वाला यह झंडा गीत भी छपता था-

आज शहीदों ने तुमको अहले-वतन ललकारा,  
तोड़ो गुलामी की जंजीरें, बरसाओ अंगारा,

हिन्दू, मुस्लिम, सिक्ख हमारा भाई भाई प्यारा,  
यह है आजादी का झंडा, इसे सलाम हमारा।।

लेकिन जिस कारण इस अखबार के प्रकाशक और संपादक को ब्रिटिश हुकूमत ने फांसी पर लटकाया, वह था अंग्रेजों को देश से निकल बाहर करने का वह फरमान जिसे 'पयाम-ए-आजादी' ने प्रमुखता से छपा था-

'हिन्दोस्तान के हिन्दुओं और मुसलमानों, उठो भाइयो उठो, खुदा ने जितनी बरकतें इंसान को अता की हैं, उनमें सबसे कीमती बरकत आजादी की है .... फिरंगियों ने इतने जुल्म किये हैं कि उनके गुनाहों का प्याला लबरेज हो चुका है .... क्या तुम अब भी खामोश बैठे रहोगे? मैं अपने तमाम हिंदी भाइयों से कहता हूँ, उठो और परमात्मा के बताये हुए इस अजीम फर्ज को पूरा करने के लिए मैदान-ए-जंग में कूद पड़ो।'

इस फरमान को प्रकाशित करने की सजा के रूप में न केवल संपादक और प्रकाशक को फांसी दी गई, बल्कि जिस जिस किसी के भी घर उसकी एक भी प्रति मिली, उसे मौत के घात उतार दिया गया। यही कारण है कि इस अखबार की एक भी प्रति देखने को नहीं मिलती।

यह फरमान 'पयाम-ए-आजादी' के आलावा हिंदी और बंगला दैनिक 'समाचार सुधावर्षण' और फारसी के अखबार 'दूरबीन' और 'सुल्तान-उल-अखबार' भी प्रकाशित हुआ था। इन तीनों पर ब्रिटिश सरकार ने राजद्रोह का मुकदमा चलाया।

### समाचार सुधावर्षण-

5, 9 और 10 जून 1857 के अंकों में 'समाचार सुधावर्षण' के संपादक श्याम सुन्दर सेन ने क्रान्तिकारी सेना की तैयारी के समाचर छापे। 5 जून के अंक में इस अखबार ने लिखा-

'मेरठ और दिल्ली की क्रांति से गवर्नर इतना डर गया कि उसने अपनी हिफाजत के लिए सिपाहियों की संख्या बढ़ा दी . ... वह हर रोज दमदम और बैरकपुर छावनियों में जाता और सिपाहियों से हाथ जोड़कर कहता कि मैं ऐसा कुछ नहीं करूँगा जिससे आपके धर्म को ठेस पहुँचे ....।'

### बंगाल गजट-

ब्रिटिश राज को उखाड़ फेंकने का यह जब्बा यकायक 1857 में पीड़ा पैदा नहीं हुआ, इसकी भूमिका बहुत पहले बननी शुरू हो गई थी। राजाराममोहन राय की प्रेरणा से प्रकाशित अखबार 'बंगाल गजट' के 5 मई, 1818 के अंक में छपी इस

खबर से जाहिर हो जाता है कि भारतीय जनमानस ने अंग्रेजों के विरुद्ध बागी तेवर अपना लिए थे-

'मिदनापुर के बागियों ने लेन को पार करके आरा पर धावा बोल दिया। अपनी सुरक्षा के सम्बन्ध में सही तौर से घबरा कर वहाँ के यूरोपियन निवासियों ने सैनिक सहायता के लिए दानापुर लिखा। यकायक दोनों तरफ से बहुत पास से उनके ऊपर जबरदस्त हमला बोल दिया गया और उनकी छोटी सी सेना के 150 आदमियों को जिनमें कई अफसर भी थे, बेकार बना दिया। अनुमान किया जाता है कि वहाँ के तमाम यूरोपियनों को जो 47 के लगभग थे, कत्ल कर दिया गया है।'

### जाम-ए-जहाँनुमा-

27 मार्च, 1822 को कोलकाता से भारत का पहला उर्दू अखबार 'जाम-ए-जहाँनुमा' प्रकाशित हुआ। इसके तीखे तेवरों से ब्रिटिश सरकार के कान खड़े हो गए थे। तत्कालीन चीफ सेक्रेटरी विलियम ब्रूथ वैंले की यह टिपण्णी इस बात की गवाह है-

'यह समाचारपत्र भविष्य में अंग्रेज सत्ता के खिलाफ आग उगलने वालों का नेतृत्व कर सकता है।'

### फ्रेंड ऑफ इंडिया-

28 मई, 1857 को 'फ्रेंड ऑफ इंडिया' में छपा कोलकाता के बिगड़ते हालात का यह समाचार तिलमिला देने वाला है-

'इस समय कलकत्ते में बड़ी गड़बड़ मची, वहाँ बहुत से ईसाई बच्चे और स्त्रियाँ थीं। वे अब तक सुरक्षित थे। ...गड़बड़ के नाम से डरते थे। बहुत से शहर छोड़ कर पास के गाँव में जा बसे। बहुतों ने इंग्लैण्ड का टिकट कटाया और बहुत से बन्दूक खरीद कर सदा पास रखने लगे।'

### सादिक-उल-अखबार-

17 सितम्बर, 1857 का दिन भारतीय पत्रकारिता के इतिहास का काला दिन साबित हुआ। ब्रिटिश हुकूमत के खिलाफ कलम का अग्निपथ रचने वाले दिल्ली से प्रकाशित 'सादिक-उल-अखबार' के संपादक अमालुद्दीन और 'देहली उर्दू अखबार' के संपादक मौलवी मोहम्मद वाकर को नीम के पेड़ से लटकाकर तोप से उड़ा दिया गया। अंतिम मुगल बादशाह बहादुर शाह जफर पर जब अंग्रेजों ने मुकदमा चलाया तो दिल्ली से प्रकाशित होने वाले जिन अखबारों को सबूत के तौर पर पेश किया गया उनमें प्रमुख थे 'सादिक-उल-अखबार' और 'खुलासत- उल-अखबार'।

### कोहेनूर-

1850 से ही लाहौर से प्रकाशित अखबार 'कोहेनूर' ने ब्रिटिश सत्ता के खिलाफ बागी तेवर अपना रखे थे। मार्च 1856 में इसके संपादक हरसुख राय को सलाखों के पीछे भेज दिया गया।

### मालवा अखबार-

21 नवम्बर, 1860 को 'मालवा अखबार' में 'पांचवीं पलटन' शीर्षक से छपी यह खबर गौर करने लायक है-

'ये गोरों की पलटन दीनापुर में थी, एक गोरा उनमें से तोप से बंधकर उड़ाया गया और बाकी मोकूफ हुए, ये सभी एक तरह के फिसादी थे ...।'

'मालवा अखबार' के संपादक को गिरफ्तार कर तीन महीने की जेल की सजा हुई और अखबार बंद कर दिया गया।

### अखबार ग्वालियर-

22 मई, 1859 को 'अखबार ग्वालियर' में 'उपद्रवता का इतिहास' शीर्षक से प्रकाशित यह खबर उल्लेखनीय है-

'...29वीं मार्च को 34वीं पलटन के एक मंगल पांडे नाम के सिपाही ने नशे में उन्मत्त होकर अपने को हथियारबंद किया, तलवार लेकर एक बन्दूक भरकर घर से निकला और अपने भाई बन्दों को पुकारा, हमारे साथी हो जाओ और उनसे यह भी कहा कि जिस किसी अंगरेज अफसर को मैं देखूँगा उसको मार डालूँगा।'

### शुभसूचक-

उन्हीं दिनों प्रकाशित एक अखबार 'शुभसूचक' में प्रकाशित यह खबर लखनऊ में अंग्रेजों द्वारा की गई लूटपाट और तबाही का सबूत पेश करती है-

'जब अंग्रेजों ने दुबारा लखनऊ शहर पर कब्जा किया तब अंग्रेजी फौज ने लखनऊ से चौदह लाख बयासी हजार छह सौ चौवन रुपये और ग्यारह पाई की लूट की थी। सरकार ने इस लूट को सिपाहियों में बाँट देने का आदेश दिया था। इनमें से अंग्रेज सेनापति लॉर्ड क्लाइव के हिस्से चौहत्तर हजार एक सौ बत्तीस रुपये आये थे।...'

### लंदन टाइम्स-

1857 की क्रांति ने एक तरह से ब्रिटिश सत्ता की चूलें हिला दीं थीं। भारत में ही नहीं विदेशी अखबारों में भी इस क्रांति के समाचार खूब छपते थे। यह बात अलग है कि उनका नजरिया अक्सर अलग होता था लेकिन कभी-कभी सच भी सामने आता

था-

'लंदन टाइम्स' के 17 जनवरी, 1859 के अंक में इसके मुंबई संवाददाता ने अपनी एक रिपोर्ट में लिखा-

'तात्या टोपे ने जिस दृढ़ता, निश्चय तथा लगन से पीछे हटाने की इस विलक्षण योजना को अंजाम दिया उसकी प्रशंसा किये बिना नहीं रहा जा सकता। पिछले जून के महीने से उसने मध्य भारत में तहलका मचा रखा है, उसने हमारे स्थानों को रौंद डाला है, खजानों को लूट लिया है और हमारे मैगजीनों को खाली कर दिया है, उसने सेनाएँ जमा कर लीं हैं ...।'

### अमृत बाजार पत्रिका-

23 जनवरी, 1875 के 'अमृत बाजार पत्रिका' के अंक में प्रकाशित दो लेखों ने न केवल भारत सरकार का ध्यान आकर्षित किया बल्कि ब्रिटेन के सेक्रेटरी ऑफ स्टेट्स लॉर्ड सेलिसबरी का भी ध्यान आकर्षित किया। लेख का भावार्थ था-'कतिपय विशिष्ट परिस्थितियों में ब्रिटिश अधिकारियों की हत्या भी जायज है।'

### मित्र विलास-

4 अक्टूबर 1880 को लाहौर से प्रकाशित 'मित्र विलास' ने अंग्रेजी साम्राज्य के षडयंत्र का कच्चा चिट्ठा प्रस्तुत किया-

'हिंदुस्तान अंग्रेजों के राज्य का एक बड़ा अंश है। अंग्रेजों का अपना देश अर्थात् ग्रेट ब्रिटेन एक छोटा टापू है, जो लम्बाई-चौड़ाई में कदाचित् हिंदुस्तान के पंचमांश के तुल्य भी नहीं है, एक ऐसे टापू के अधिपति होकर इन लोगों ने शनैः-शनैः हाथ मारे। सौदागरों का एक दल आ कर 23,00,000 वर्ग मील के एक राज्य को अपने हाथ में कर ले, किसको सत्य प्रतीत होता था। .. जिन दिनों यह हिंदुस्तान किसी यूरोपीय के नीचे नहीं था, सारे धरातल पर बड़ा धनी माना जाता था, परन्तु वह धन कहाँ गया? केवल पुराने अंग्रेजों के अत्याचार और आजकल के अंग्रेजों के बहुव्यय से लुट गया और लुटता जा रहा है।'

### हिंदी प्रदीप-

1877 में प्रकाशित 'हिंदी प्रदीप' को भारत का पहला राजनीतिक पत्र माना जाता है। अनेक कानूनी व्यवधानों से गुजरते हुए अंततः 1908 में इसे बंद हो जाना पड़ा। बंग-भंग आन्दोलन के दौरान बम बनाने और फेंकने की क्रान्तिकारी गतिविधियों के बीच माधव शुक्ल द्वारा लिखी यह कविता 'बम क्या है' छाप दी थी। इसके प्रकाशन के लिए 'हिंदी प्रदीप' से 3000 रुपये की जमानत मांगी गई।

## केसरी-

लोकमान्य बाल गंगाधर तिलक की अगुआई में 'केसरी' ने अंग्रेजों के खिलाफ जमकर बिगुल फूँका। 1882 में इसके खिलाफ ब्रिटिश कार्रवाई का सिलसिला शुरू हो गया था। तिलक और उनके सहयोगी गोपाल गणेश आगरकर के विरुद्ध मुकदमा चलाया और दोनों को 4-4 माह की कैद की सजा सुनाई गई। 1897 में फिर तिलक पर राजद्रोह का मुकदमा चला और उन्हें डेढ़ साल की सजा हुई, लेकिन 'केसरी' की दहाड़ कम नहीं हुई।

## गदर-

इन अखबारों के जरिये राष्ट्रप्रेम और स्वाधीनता की मशाल लगातार तेज होती रही। इसी जज्बे के चलते 1913 में अमरीका के सेनफ्रांसिस्को शहर से प्रवासी भारतीयों ने 'गदर' नाम से एक अखबार निकाला जिसके मास्टहेड पर चुनौती के रूप में लिखा होता था-

'अंग्रेजों का दुश्मन'

इसके पहले अंक में एक विज्ञापन छपा था-

आवश्यकता है बहादुर सैनिकों की

तनखावाह-मौत, कीमत-शहादत, पेंशन-आजादी,  
जंग-ए-मैदान-हिंदुस्तान

## स्वराज्य-

इलाहाबाद से प्रकाशित होने वाला 'स्वराज्य' एक ऐसा अखबार था जिसके एक नहीं, बल्कि लगातार आठों संपादकों को काला पानी की सजा हुई। जब एक संपादक को काला पानी की सजा होती तो 'स्वराज्य' में विज्ञापन छपता-

'स्वराज्य को चाहिए एक संपादक-

वेतन-दो सूखी रोटियाँ और एक गिलास ठंडा पानी।

और हर सम्पादकीय के लिए दस साल की सजा।'

हर बार विज्ञापन छपने के बाद संपादक पद के लिए आवेदनों की कतार लग जाती थी।

## अल हिलाल-

मौलाना अबुल कलाम आजाद के अखबार 'अल हिलाल' के ब्रिटिश सत्ता विरोधी तेवरों के कारण 16 नवम्बर, 1914 को 2000 रुपये की जमानत मांगी गई। आजाद ने यह देने से मना कर दिया और अखबार बंद कर दिया गया।

## भारत मित्र-

ब्रिटिश शासन की भारत-विरोधी नीतियों ने 'भारत मित्र' को विदेशी सत्ता के प्रतिकार के तीखे तेवर प्रदान किये। 'भारत मित्र' को लोकप्रियता के शिखर पर पहुँचाने वाले संपादक बाल मुकुंद गुप्त द्वारा लिखे 'शिव-शम्भू के चिट्ठे' धारदार व्यंग्य के अनूठे उदहारण हैं। 'कर्जन' की खिल्ली उड़ाती यह कविता उल्लेखनीय है-

नानी बोली टेसू लाल, कहती हूँ तुझसे सब हाल  
मास नवम्बर कर्जन लाट, उलट चले शासन की खाट

किया मातरम् बन्दे बंद,

जोर स्वदेशी का दबवाया, जगह-जगह पर लठ चलवाया।

## हंस-

1930 में 'हंस' पत्रिका के संपादक मुंशी प्रेमचंद से भी 1000 रुपये की जमानत मांगी गई। जब कोई भी प्रेस 'हंस' छापने को तैयार नहीं हुआ तो पत्रिका पाँच महीने के लिए बंद हो गई। 1936 में सेठ गोविन्द दस का लेख 'स्वतंत्रता' प्रकाशित करने पर 'हंस' से फिर जमानत मांगी गई।

## जागरण-

प्रेमचंद के 'जागरण' के 27 अक्टूबर, 1932 के अंक में उनकी कहानी 'उसका अंत' प्रकाशित हुई, जिसे अंग्रेजों ने अपने ऊपर साधा गया निशाना माना और 'जागरण' और उसकी प्रेस 'सरस्वती' से एक हजार रुपये जुर्माना माँगा। तब प्रेमचंद ने लिखा-

'ऐसे वातावरण में जबकि हर एक संपादक के सर पर तलवार लटक रही हो, राष्ट्र का सच्चा राजनीतिक विकास नहीं हो सकता। अधिकारियों के हाथ में इतना अधिकार दे दिया गया है कि कोई संपादक अफसरों की आलोचना करके सुख की नींद सो नहीं सकता है। ...हमें भय है कि इन प्रतिकूल दशाओं में समाचारपत्रों का बढ़ना-पनपना कठिन हो जायेगा।

सिर्फ ऊपर उद्धृत अखबार ही नहीं, सैकड़ों ऐसे अखबार देश की विभिन्न भाषाओं में प्रकाशित हुए जिन्होंने आजादी के आन्दोलन के दौर में जनमानस को अंग्रेजों के खिलाफ बगावत को उकसाया और राष्ट्रप्रेम, राष्ट्रवाद का सन्देश दिया। येथे वे कलम सिपाही जो-जिए जब तक लिखे खबरनामे, चल दिए हाथ में कलम थामे।
